Construction Foreman Responsibilities

- Coordinating construction work according to priorities and plans
- Ensure manpower and resources are adequate
- Produce schedules and monitor attendance of crews, both Winsome and subcontracted crews
- Coordinate essential personnel on-site.
- Schedule work for the Winsome crew. Allocate general and daily responsibilities.
- Supervise and train workers and tradespeople
- Manage supplies, materials, and equipment.
- Read and interpret site plans, construction drawings and scopes of work.
- Guarantee quality standards are met.
- Maintain a professional appearance and attitude while on job sites, especially in front of customers
- Resolve problems when they arise
- Perform construction work duties including but not limited to:
- Specialty carpentry and/or other construction projects as defined by the Site Superintendent and Project Manager.
- Miscellaneous punch list and warranty items on jobsites
- Clean up labor on jobsites as needed
- Pick up/Delivering materials to jobsites as needed
- Serve as Safety Coordinator
- Guarantee all safety standards are met
- Communicate and enforce all safety regulations.
- Ensure that crew wears appropriate protection at all times when required,(i.e. safety glasses, hard hat, etc.)
- Participate in required safety training
- Supervise the use of machinery and equipment
- Handling Functions of Personnel
- Keep track of all time in BuilderTrend and miles and expenses in an organized spreadsheet
- Assist in oversight of time card submissions of crew through BuilderTrend.
- Work with all field staff to ensure a clear accounting of work completed
- Submit Daily Logs on BuilderTrend for all job sites and ensure that all crews have submitted Daily Logs.
- Attend staff meetings when required
- Report Progress
- Report on progress to Site Superintendent and Project Manager
